- Members of the SHAC come from the community and school district
- Majority must be parents who are not employed by the district
- Must meet at least 4 times each year
- Ensures that local community values are reflected in health education instruction

- Made up of PE & Health teachers from campuses across the district
- All campuses were provided the opportunity to participate
- Includes elementary and middle school teachers (K-8)

Textbook Adoption Process



1. *Distribute agreements to all publishers (September)*
2. *Review eligible publishers textbook fairs (November)*
3. *District Committee meeting (January)*
4. *Samples available to campuses (January)*
5. *Final campus vote (February)*
6. *Public Availability for Review & Feedback (April / May)*
7. *Board - Future Action (April)*
8. *Board action (May)*
