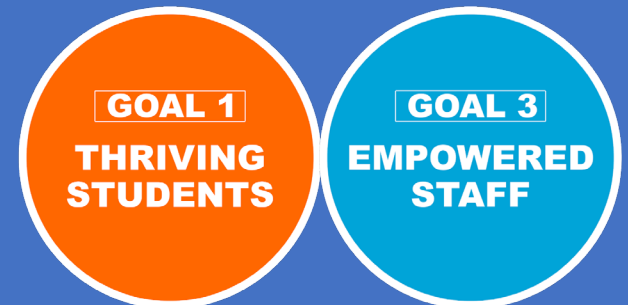




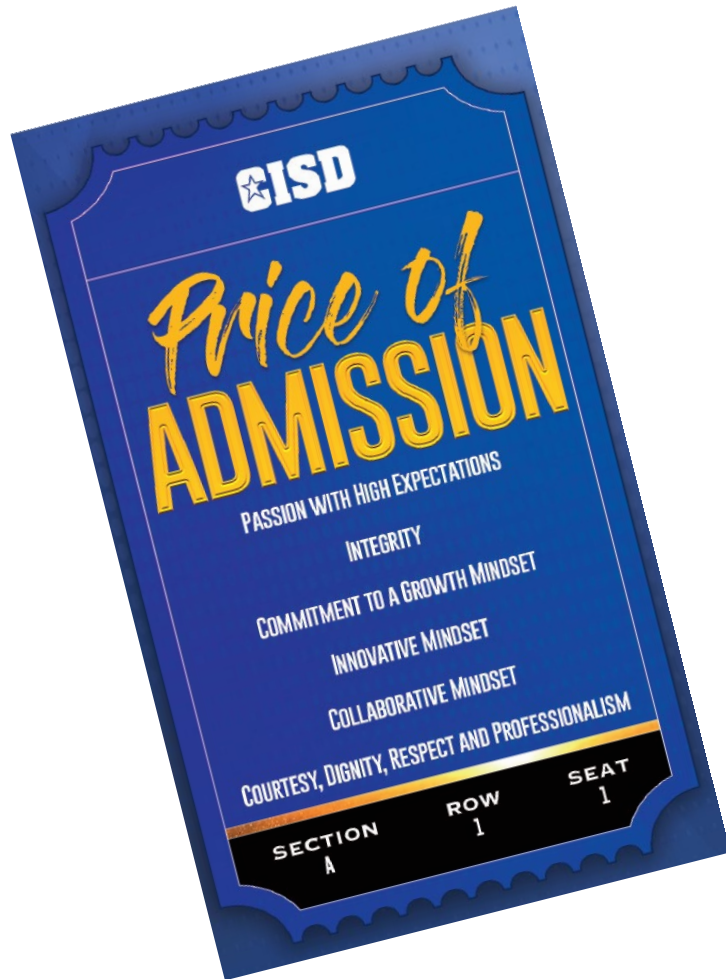

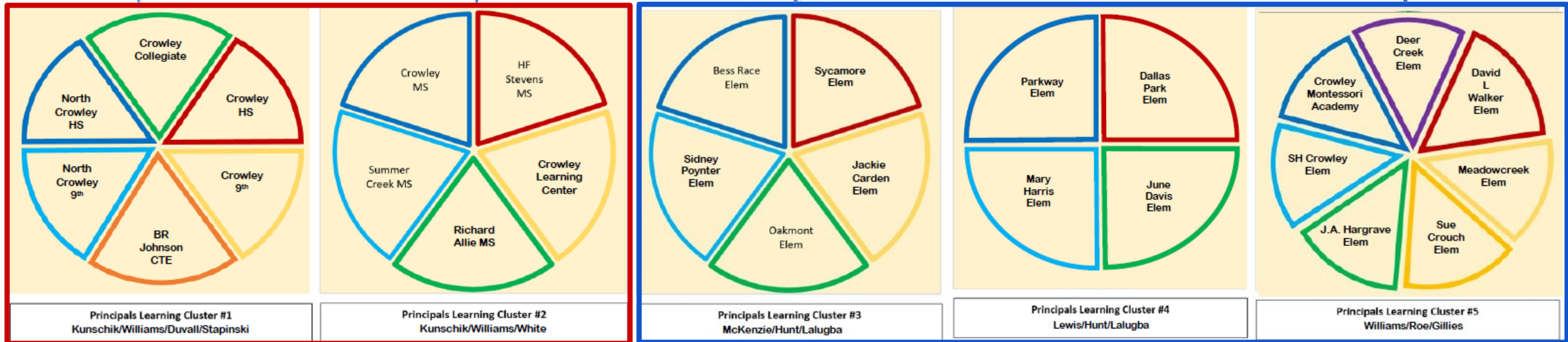
Overview: Principals Learning Clusters

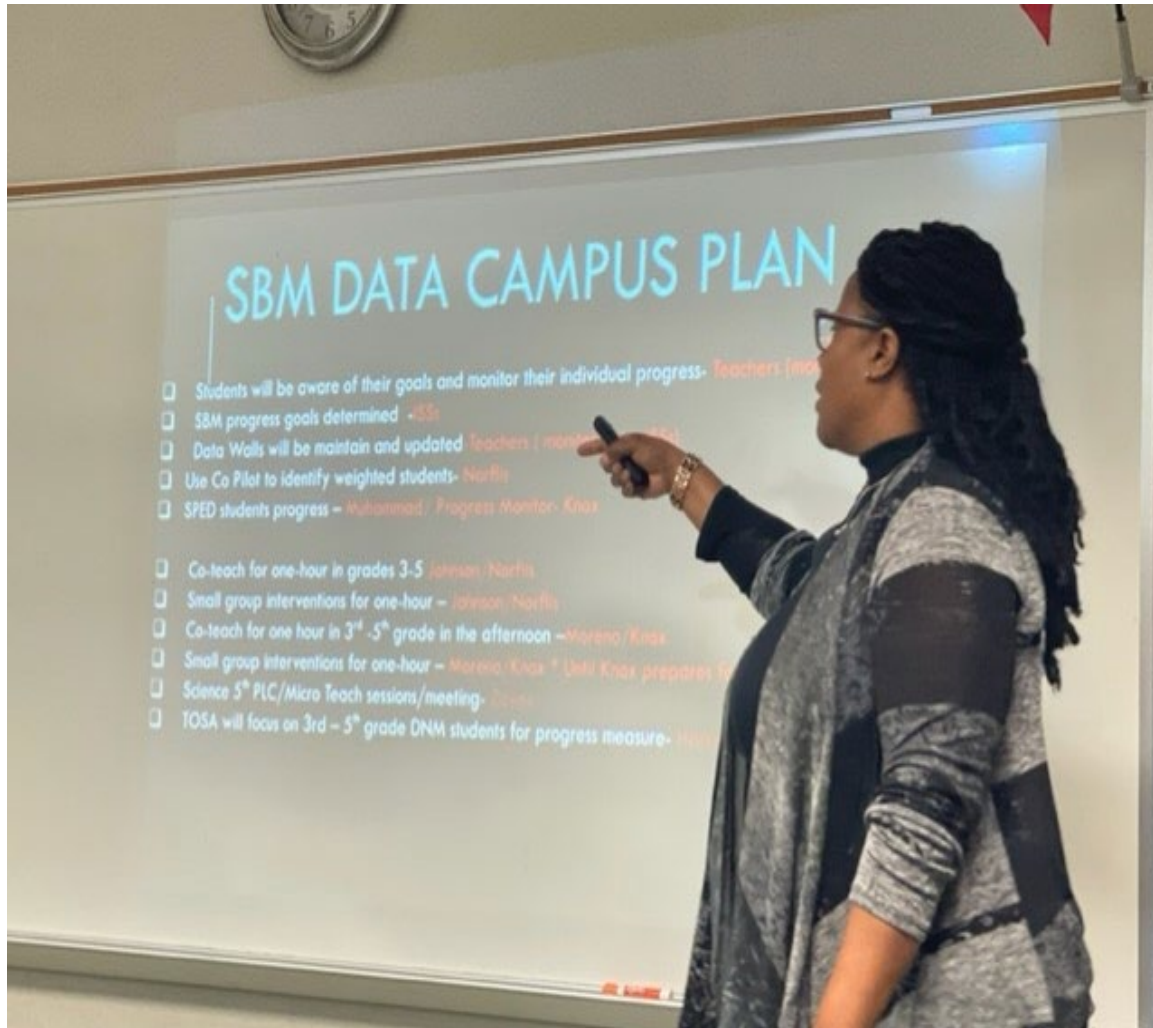

Campus Performance Review (CPR): Purpose and Practice



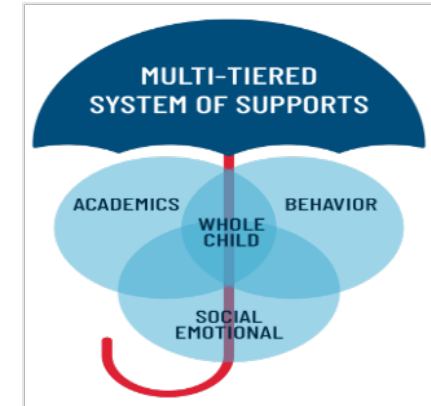

Executive Directors Role in CPR Preparation:

- Developing a strategic plan of action
- Narrow leadership focus to specific content area/problem of practice
- Ensuring collective campus ownership of the data
- Advocating for district level support to remove campus level barriers



Executive Directors Actions:

- Comprehensive analysis of campus data.
- Asking reflective/critical questions to identify the problem of practice.
- Provide feedback based on leadership's observation of data.
- Guide and identify highest leverage area for problem of practice based on data.
- Conduct mock CPR meeting using district CPR template.
