Social Media

During the Spring semester, there were three negative social media posts with comments on products being overcooked or having discoloration.

- Through our investigation, we were able to contact all three individuals that created the posts.
- Investigation results:
 - All products were deemed food safe
 1. **Beef Patty**- was found to be overcooked and immediately removed from service
 2. **Corn Dog**- upon inspection of the remaining product onsite, no other issues were identified
 3. **Popcorn Chicken**- was found to be safe to eat. A small portion had been burnt in the oven

After a full investigation, all staff was reminded of the procedures that ensure quality control at the service line, and additional quality assurance audits were implemented.

Improvement Plan

- Elevated food tier
 - 100% beef patties
 - Chicken products are made with 100% whole muscle
 - Added additional Made to Order options at secondary campuses
