 Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a researched based, proactive approach to establishing the behavioral supports and social culture needed for all students in a school to achieve social, emotional, and academic success.





Why PBIS at HFS?




- To implement a research-based systematic approach to campus culture

Discipline System Components


The Four Components of Preventive Discipline

- All students follow the same set of rules and expectations throughout all areas in the building.
- When students follow the rules and expectations, they are recognized with PBIS Rewards points
- When students do not follow the rules, there are planned consequences to help them get back on track.


