Why ADSY?



- Addresses the problem of summer learning loss
- Increases academic achievement
- Adds 30 days for additional instruction, enrichment and intervention
- Allows additional time for SEL, mental breaks and unstructured play
- Additional time for teacher collaboration

The Difference



- Half-day funding for 30 additional days
- Teachers start July 6, 2021 (Professional Development)
- School starts July 12, 2021 (Accelerated Academy)
- School ends June 3, 2021

 During the Accelerated Academy, students will focus on above-grade level and off-grade level skills mastery

Community/Parents Impacts

- CISD parents will have option to opt-in or opt-out using transfer protocol
- Additional early childhood options for younger children

Student Impact

 Students will have additional days, but will have the same holiday breaks proposed in the draft of the 2021-2022 school calendar

Teacher Impact

- Strategic staffing will take place at David Walker. Teachers who want to stay at David Walker will reapply or will be reassigned to another CISD campus.
- Teachers will receive pay differential for working at David Walker Elementary

Components



- Increased time for recess and unstructured play time
- Weekly teacher collaboration and professional development
- Focus on math and literacy skills at every grade level
- More collaboration with 21st Century After-School Program

Components



- Campus wide implementation of Gomez and Gomez instructional model
- Teacher looping (Grades K-1) (Grades 2-3) (Grades 4-5)
- Additional supports for the whole child and building relationships with student and families

CISD and Child Care Associates Partnership

EARLY HEAD START MONTESSORI

- Target student population: EHS eligible and tuition students (6 wks. to 36 mos. old)
 - o 12 community students
 - 12 tuition students (children of CISD staff)
- · Who pays?
 - CCA costs: projected \$175,000*
 - Director (60%)
 - 1 Family Engagement Advocate
 - 3 staff
 - Furniture
 - Curriculum and materials
 - CISD costs: projected \$500,000*
 - Director (40%)
 - Renovation
 - 3-6 staff
 - Potential funding source
 - Up to \$90,000 for tuition students

HEAD START PREK PLUS

- Target student population: Head Start eligible and tuition students (3 & 4 yrs. old)
 - o 37 students
 - o 2 classrooms
- · Who pays?
 - o CCA costs: \$130,000
 - Furnishings and materials
 - 1 teacher and 1 aide
 - o CISD costs: \$130k
 - 1 teacher and 1 aide
 - Curriculum and materials

CISD GENERAL ED. PREK

- Target student population: Gen. ed. and tuition students (3 & 4 yrs. old)
 - o 44 students
 - o 2 classrooms
- · CISD projected cost \$230,000
 - o 2 teachers and 2 aides.
 - o Curriculum and materials
 - Potential funding source: up to \$30,000-40,000 (10 tuition seats)

CISD MONTESSORI EARLY CHILDHOOD

- Target student population: Head Start, gen ed. and tuition students (3-6 yrs. old)
 - o 22 students
 - o 1 classroom
- CISD projected cost: \$140,000
 - o 1 teacher and 1 aide
 - Professional development
 - Furnishings
 - Curriculum and materials
 - Potential funding source: up to \$30,000-40,000 (10 tuition seats)
