- UT OnRamps has customized their catalog to reflect the evolving needs of CISD teachers which allows users to explore concise, curated content
- Modules contain interactive activities and downloadable documents that support direct application to classroom contexts
- The self-paced modules address critical classroom needs on distance education
- UT OnRamps Distance Learning Center staff will offer timely feedback to participants

- 2. Authentic Assessment in Online Learning

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### **Crowley ISD's Role**

- Submit required assignments for review and feedback
- Collaborate with UT OnRamps staff on changes needed to the modules





### **OnRamps' Role**





- Provide platform for modules Canvas
- Register staff in Canvas and offer technical support as needed
- Provide members of the UT OnRamps Distance Learning Department to review and to give feedback for all assignments/tasks submitted by CISD staff
- Collaborate with CISD district staff on the modules and the changes/additions needed to better meet teachers' needs
