The purpose of College, Career, and Military readiness is to ensure that all Crowley ISD students have access to high-quality pathways to career and college for post-secondary readiness.

- **40%** College, Career, Military Ready (CCMR)
- **20%** Graduation Rates

All graduating senior **must** complete at least one of the following:

- Meet TSI criteria in ELA/reading *and* mathematics on assessments or complete college prep courses
- Meet AP/IB criteria
- Earn dual credits
- Earn an approved industry-based certification
- Earn an associate degree
- Graduate with a completed IEP and workforce readiness
- Earn a Level 1 or Level 2 certificate
- Complete an OnRamps dual enrollment course
- Graduate under an advanced diploma plan and be identified as a current special education student
- Complete a CTE coherent sequence of courses (new for 2022-23)

•T3 Last Dollar Scholarships*

Covers any remaining tuition costs after Pell grants and/or other federal, state, or institutional aid have been applied. In other words, last dollar scholarships cover the gap – any last dollars needed to cover student's tuition.

Does **not** cover housing, books, and other fees. ***Income Threshold Required for All**



Available at all T3 Partner Institutions of Higher Education

T3 First Dollar Scholarships*

First dollar scholarships are applied before any other financial aid is applied and disbursed directly to the student through their bank account, *not* through their university. The amount does not change even if the student receives other state, federal, or institutional aid. *Income Thresholds Required for All

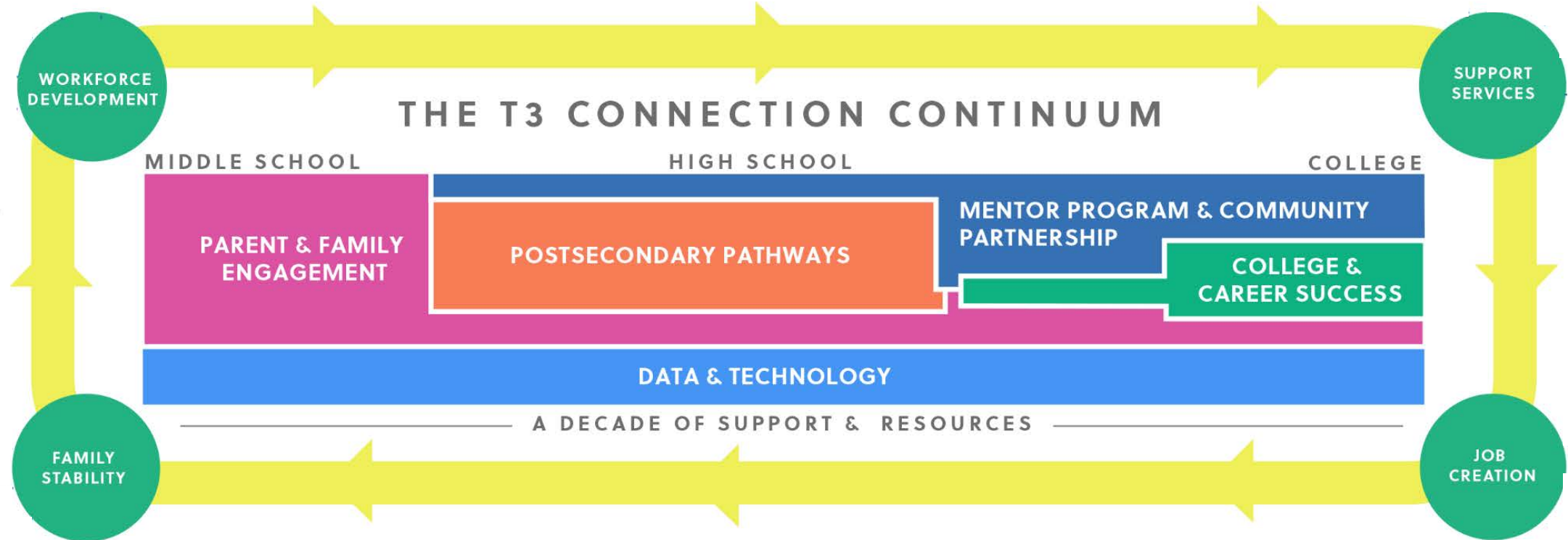
\$500 Per Year = \$2,000 Total
