EOS' MISSION


Ensure students of all backgrounds have equal access to America's most academically intense high school programs and particularly that students of color and low-income students have opportunities to succeed at the highest levels.

25–29-year-olds in the United States that have attained a bachelor's degree or higher as of 2018



EXAMPLE OPPORTUNITY CHART <u>161</u> Students in TARGET GROUP Currently Enrolled in AP/IB/AICE









"'I'd love for teachers to help me make it to college. My dream is to have a degree, make my family proud, and do what love to do – medicine."


"I do not ask questions because I don't want to seem unintelligent, so I keep most of them to myself."




KEISHA'S COMMENTS:

EVERY STUDENT HAS A STORY BEHIND THEM






MY STORY BEGAN WITH A NO.
